
I am directed to refer to this Department's letter No. j-117/1/2023-Fy/E-23239 dated 26th February, 2024, through which the Administrative Approval of Government of India for extension of the Fisheries Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF) for a period of another 3 years from 01.04.2023 to 31.3.2026 within the already approved fund size of Rs 7522.48 crore and budgetary support of Rs 939.48 crore has been issued to all the States/UTs and other stakeholders for implementation of the scheme.

2. In continuation, it is reiterated that that amongst the others, the Government has also approved the proposal to provide credit guarantee facility to the projects of entrepreneurs, individual farmers and cooperatives to be approved under FIDF during the extended period of 3 years from FY 2023-24 to FY2025-26 i.e. till 31.3.2026 from the existing credit guarantee fund under the Infrastructure Development Fund(IDF) of the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying(DAHD), Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying.

3. It is informed that the Credit Guarantee for Infrastructure Development Fund (IDF) of the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying (DAHD), Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying is managed by M/s Nabsanrakshan Trustee Pvt Limited, a wholly owned 100% subsidiary of NABARD. Accordingly, the Guidelines on Credit Guarantee Scheme for loans to be sanctioned under Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF) have been formulated in consultation with the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, NABARD and M/s Nabsanrakshan Trustee Pvt Limited.

4. The Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying vide its OM No. AA-17/10/2024-NLM-DADF dated 2nd September, 2024 has conveyed consent/support to the credit guarantee scheme for the loans to be sanctioned under Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development fund (FIDF).

5. The Guidelines on Credit Guarantee Scheme are hereby issued with the approval of competent authority for providing credit guarantee facilities to the fisheries projects of entrepreneurs, individual farmers and cooperatives to be approved under Fisheries Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF) during the extended period of 3 years from FY 2023-24 to 2025-26 from the existing credit guarantee fund of Infrastructure Development Fund of Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying.


